Every PIE PowerPoint Program has an accompanying resource file of printable documents which includes:

- ❖ User's Guide

For group sessions, this guide provides information a facilitator needs to present the program and set up KlickerZ, if using. Numerous recommendations are made to involve participants and create relevance to the specific campus.

- ❖ KlickerZ Beginner User's Guide

This guide provides easy, step-by-step instructions for using the KlickerZ classroom response system.

- ❖ Ice Breakers

Several options are offered for getting the session started with group discussion and interaction.

- ❖ Session Highlights

This handout provides an outline and some details of the session topics so that participants have a guide for note-taking and follow-up activities.

- ❖ Case Studies

For use during the session or as a follow-up activity after the session, several case studies are offered that reinforce the information in the program.

- ❖ Certificates

Participants appreciate receiving a certificate that verifies their participation in the session. Copies of certificates can also be placed in the instructors' training files as validation for agency requirements.

- ❖ Opinionaire

This document is useful in getting participant insight and feedback prior to the session. It can verify that even instructors who have been teaching for years will benefit from the program.

- ❖ Quiz

Every PIE program has a testing component that verifies each instructor's understanding of the content. The quiz can be conducted in several ways. For group sessions, it can be the wrap-up activity with or without the use of KlickeZ. For group sessions or individual use, the quiz can be printed and completed by each participant. Some schools keep the quiz in each instructor's training file as verification of participation. Another option for use involves giving the quiz sometime after the session to review and reinforce the program content.
